President – Travis: Opening with welcome. Will be attending the GCF meeting on Nov 9.

Announced that Heather Elliott resigned from treasurer position. Samantha Desmarais has accepted the position as treasurer.

VP2 - John: DYSC will be participating in 2 parades: Deltona and Orange City. John will submit application to the city. The U12B will be in the Deltona parade. Committee Reports

Fields – Travis: The last day to use the fields is Sunday, Nov. 15. We have a new American flag for the flag pole. We will have a DYSC flag soon. We will have new signage soon.

Travel Registrar – Boys: We have 178 boys registered.

We have GOSA bringing on 3 more teams. This should be about 30 more players for our club. They are from Kissimmee and have been under the name of MSA (My Soccer Academy). Someone needs to address the issue of uniforms with this team ASAP. They are currently just training and this will be their first time playing league games. They will form 3 teams to be declared into the GCF D3 division.

Travel Registrar & bookkeeper:

3 players are past due U19 boys, 1 boy (Mathew Coehlo) is past due and family quit and is moving

GOSA – 80 players, 77 paid in full, 1 with CC in GotSoccer

2 players Traci is working with Mario to collect, pulled the pass on 1 player, others says check is in the mail.

This does not count the Special players that have moved and been released.
