Minutes from previous meeting approved by Traci Kutsko, seconded by Jim D'Errico

Travis: Opening with welcome. He attended GCF meeting. Expect proposed budget changes for the 2016-2017 year. AGM meeting is next week. He reminds those attending they must bring their prepaid card.

Travis (Rose): Financial information available upon request to members only

VP – Jim: City approved lights at Wes Crile, Campbell, and Dwight Hawkins. Lights should be up and operational by winter. Users will be required to purchase permits for use. Dewey fields are dry/browened out due to 2 pumps breaking down. We may need to shuffle high school teams. Fields will be lined at the last minute. Website will be updated with field status.

VP – John: Approximately 300 fliers were handed out at Dewey on July 4th. Discussed where we can post yard signs. Jim will see if City will advertise the Club on their electronic signs within the City. Need additional volunteers to promote the Club.

Travis/Traci: Received 18 financial aid applications. Approximately 12 have all paperwork in. There are a total of 32 scholarships to give.

Fields Manager: SR Academy may change to Friday nights. Need volunteers to line fields Thursday nights or early Fridays.

Scheduler: There will be very little change in travel schedules this year. Need a list of all coaches including when and where they practice.

Travel Registrar – Boys & Girls: Total registered is 164 for 2015/2016. (This is the same amount at this time compared to 2014/2015.)

Girls – 8 teams total (same as last year)

89 individuals (108 last year)

Boys – 10 teams total (same as last year)
First game August 15 for U15 & older.
First game August 29 for U9 – U14.

Academy Bookkeeper & Registrar: Junior & Senior Academy
10 players paid in full
3 payment plans & have made first payment
4 payment plans & have NOT made first payment
1 waiting for OK

Junior Academy – 10 registered (7 last year)
Senior Academy – 8 registered (3 last year)
Registrar is receiving more calls and contact from parents asking questions.

Orlando: Working on finding additional coaches. Player numbers are fluctuating but numbers are still consistent. Summer camp generated 6-7 new players coming to Club. Coaching fee schedule must be followed by all coaches.

Old Business:

- E Class - 10 completed
- D Class scheduled for end of January 2016
- Summer Camp – Went well & kids enjoyed. Approximately 50 kids over 3 weeks. Will have more time to plan next camp. Suggested to have earlier pre-registration for future camps.

New Business:

- **Kenny:** Will return on August 8 after he completes his NY camp. He proposed to start JR Academy the week after Labor Day. He wants to align his groups with the regular soccer schedule. Proposed to have practice on Wednesdays and games on Fridays.
Voiced concerns include: parents used to a certain schedule, high school & Pop Warner football games, and late notice to all involved but it could work very well in the future. Will revisit after fall season and before spring season.
